EMERGENCY RESPONSE SPECIALIST

Full time position

Responsible for direct client services after the occurrence of a domestic violence incident. Works primarily with law enforcement and teams of volunteers and staff members to provide victim services on a 24-hour a day basis. Manages the SPAN Domestic Abuse Response Team (DART). Duties include being available by pager weekdays between 6am and 6pm to respond to police requests for English/Spanish emergency response and advocacy to victims of domestic violence; maintaining 24/7 on-call schedule for DART shifts for volunteers, staff, and interns; providing follow up with urgent or “unable to contact” cases; facilitating trainings; and communicating with District Attorney's office, police departments, jail officials, and other criminal legal system professionals in Boulder and Broomfield Counties.

Must have a B.A. in human services or equivalent experience, be Spanish and English proficient, have experience working with and advocating for crime victims, and possess knowledge of the legal system. The position requires a demonstrated commitment to anti-violence, anti-racism, & social justice work.
