Ensures survivors' access to programs and services in Boulder and Broomfield counties. Facilitates trainings to community groups, law enforcement and justice system personnel. Works with victim services, immigrant rights groups, social justice groups, and attorneys.

Must have a B.A. in human services or equivalent experience, be Spanish and English proficient, have experience working with and advocating for crime victims, and possess knowledge of the legal system. The position requires a demonstrated commitment to anti-violence, anti-racism, & social justice work.
